Subject: 2009-10 NCLB Highly Qualified Teacher Report

Pursuant to the federal legislation of the No Child Left Behind Act each year school districts must submit a detailed report of the status of its campuses in the effort to meet the requirement of 100% highly qualified teaching staff in the core subject areas. The core subject areas are Math, Science, English/Reading, History/Social Studies, Foreign Language and Fine Arts.

The report date of campus status was due on November 6, 2009, however, the Highly Qualified Teacher Compliance Report is to reflect the campus' qualified status as of September 15, 2009. Campuses are required to amend the highly qualified teacher report as changes occur.

The following is a break down of each campus and its current status as of today.
