Survey Information

- 🌀 Surveys have been distributed in printed form at numerous school related events and community events. The survey is in English and Spanish.
- 🌀 An online version of the survey has been created. It is accessible on the district website.
- 🌀 Cards have been created and placed throughout the community to provide information about the survey and its availability on the website.
- 🌀 Survey responses will be accepted through October 15, 2008.
- 🌀 As of October 8, 2008 there were 203 online surveys submitted and over 488 printed surveys submitted.

Application Information

- 🌀 An application for anyone interested in being considered to serve on the 30 member Strategic Planning Team has been posted on the district website.
- 🌀 Printed applications are available in the lobby of the Administration building.
- 🌀 Applications will be accepted through October 15, 2008.
- 🌀 As of October 8, 2008 the application has been accessed sixty-four times, with 21 completed applications being submitted.
- 🌀 A PDF version of the application has been added to the website for increased accessibility.

Application Process

- 🌀 Those interested in being considered to serve on the 30 initial member team is to complete an application and have it submitted by October 15, 2008.
- 🌀 All applicants will be invited to attend an informational overview of the expectations and a description of the process for those wishing to serve on the team that is planned for Monday, October 20, 2008 from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.
- 🌀 On Tuesday, October 21, 2008 the Strategic Planning Team of 30 will be selected and notified. They will be asked to respond within 24 hours.
- 🌀 Anyone submitting an application will be given an opportunity to serve on an Action Team.
